We use his SAI Weather Advisor here at the Tri-Cities Airport and find it very useful for several reason. Our tenant/pilots use it on a regular basis. Our student pilots in our flight school have maximum wind requirements and can access that info via our website <a href="https://www.GoodrichAviation.com">www.GoodrichAviation.com</a> to tell whether or not they can fly. Weather information is critical to making good flying decisions and a pilot can never get to much. Having actual weather info from the local airport instead of a larger airport from several miles away can only make flying safer. I like and feel comfortable with the SAI system because it take its information from a FAA certified automated weather observation system (AWOS) and presents it in a clear, understandable way. I can then link that info to my website for everyone to benefit from it.

I would recommend using Mr. Stanwyck's system and making it available to your pilots.
